- You may be eligible to receive a maximum of \$583.08 per month for each eligible child under the age of 6 (\$491.91 per month aged 6-17) through the Tax Free Canada Child Benefit.
- You may qualify for Canada Pension Plan and Old Age Security Benefits if you lived or worked in a country with which Canada has an International Social Security Agreement.
- You can monitor, view and update your information for Employment Insurance (EI), Canada Pension Plan (CPP).
